SHUT OUT SCAMMERS

Two words that will help us beat doorstep crime "no thanks"



Anyone can be a victim of household scams It's never easy to spot a bogus caller.



Be wary of cold callers at the door and on the phone, scammers can appear very legitimate

Doorstep Checklist

- If in doubt; keep them out
- · LOCK, STOP, CHAIN and CHECK
- · LOCK Keep front and back doors locked
- STOP Don't open the door until you have checked through a viewer or window to see who is there
- CHAIN Use a door chain or bar
- CHECK Only let callers in if they have an appointment and you have confirmed they are genuine
- Always ask for ID
- Call the published number from the internet or phone directory not use a telephone number provided by the caller. for their company or service to check if they are legitimate. Do
